

Troop 64 Committee Meeting

May 19, 2008

Diane opened our meeting with an update on registering for Jamboree (2010). The council will take up all paperwork on May 31st and a \$100 deposit. In Dec. we will know who the 36 boys who will go. The council will have a selection process by which they will weed out and prioritize (b/c of age, etc.) but some boys of all ages will be selected. Once selected, there will be 3 specific boy-only training sessions that the scouts must attend. They will travel by chartered bus to D.C. The cost will be \$2100-2500 + uniforms. There will be fundraising opportunities and a pmt schedule of about \$150-200/mo beginning in 2009. Boys from 80 different countries will attend.

OUTDOOR Chair: Dora reported the boys will meet Sat. at Garland at the J Campsite across from the old trading post around 7:30-8:00 for the Camping Merit Badge activities.

ADVANCEMENT: 2 more scouts have earned 2nd class and 1 made T'foot. Ryan is going tomorrow to turn in his paperwork and will then be due to have his Board of Review for Eagle.

QUARTERMASTER: Bill asked if there had ever been a meeting with the Quartermasters (scheduled in March). Jared has been made new Q-master and binders were passed out a few weeks ago with information and checklists regarding each patrol checking in and out equipment.

The Wilderness Survival Demo at Bass Pro Shop will be cancelled so the boys can go to Garland. The only thing left for the boys who have been working on this badge for 1 + yrs. is to make a checklist of personal gear, present a packed backpack to Brad and #10.

Brad wanted to remind everyone that we changed the starting time for troop meeting to 6:30 and that is when the flag ceremony should begin. Please be on time.

Jill reminded Brad he needs to update the committee minutes on the web site. He will do that.

Summer attire for meetings (as of May 31) is troop t-shirt (or any scout t-shirt if you don't have a troop shirt) + khaki shorts or scouts shorts. If you wear scout shorts you need to wear scout socks. Belts also need to be worn
